The meat was carved and presented well, the carvery as well as all the trimmings; the potatoes were crispy on the outside





and fluffy on the inside and steaming hot when you cut into them. Monty is quite the meat lover and couldn't believe how much she was given for such a reasonable price.

Two courses - a full roast dinner and a selection of desserts - is on offer every Sunday for just £10.

My colleague, Alexandra, went for beef, pork belly and a roasted onion as well as the vegetables and mushroom gravy. She said the beef was very tender and the cauliflower cheese was a nice accompaniment on the side.

However, she was most impressed with the Yorkshire pudding, which she said was very substantial and had some lovely flavoured herbs sprinkled on top. My boyfriend Alex went for the pork ribs, like Monty, and agreed they were cooked perfectly and the meat just fell off the

He also had some southern fried chicken, which I thought was an unusual way to serve chicken for a carvery but actually looked delicious. He said it was nice and juicy with a crispy coating

definitely not too much to handle. The service was very efficient and friendly. Jill and the staff were quick to ask us if there was anything we needed and if everything was OK with the food. For pudding I had hot apple pie, Alexandra went for strawberry jelly. Monty chose the chocolate fudge cake and Alex had a Christmas Yule log.

Jill offered us whipped cream with each of our choices and of course we all said At first we weren't sure we would be able

to handle dessert after taking on such large main courses, but fear not - we polished it all off. Alexandra's strawberry jelly was nice and

fruity and clearly a firm favourite as she grabbed the last one in the fridge. Sometimes I think apple pie can be a little tart, but this one wasn't at all. I



could really taste the apple and Jill warmed it up for me, which gave the pastry a lovely

Monty's chocolate cake was just immense. She said it was rich and moist and the chocolate icing was so soft and creamy.

The chocolate fudge cake was another dessert which could have been served warm, as well as the rice pudding which was also

available. Between the four of us we sampled every meat and all the trimmings on the carvery and almost all of the desserts in the refrigerator and were really impressed

My friends and family know how much I like a home-cooked roast dinner on a Sunday, and something about Cafe Amiti gave me that homey feeling I enjoy so

As well as the lovely food, kind staff and huge variety of food, the staff had made

a real effort with Christmas decorations and giving the dining area a welcoming From young to old, a wide variety of the community seemed to be enjoying their


